Listed are a few of the rules that are being overlooked:

- \*Proper swim wear is required\* No denim, cutoffs, cotton or street-wear. = Fibers from these materials clog the pool pump system
- \*Please use swim diapers for little ones. = Sanitary reasons
- \* No food, drink or gum is allowed in the pool or at pool edge.
- \* Balloons and confetti are not allowed.
- \* Guest policy = Must not exceed number of allowed guests. If exceeded, you will be required to contact the rental coordinator and complete a pool party rental contract.
- \* Smoking = please use the designated area on the far side of pool, near the courts.
