Did you know...that SA has a "pooper scooper" law?

"A pet owner or keeper *shall not* walk his/her dogs *without* a leash restraint, and shall not guide or take animals

onto the yards or driveways or property not owned, leased or occupied by the animal owner for the purpose

of allowing the animal to defecate, but shall keep his/her animal in the public right-of-way, and shall carry

a container and scooper for the sanitary removal of his/her animal's fecal matter from the public right-of-way."
